**Registration** Registration forms are to be completed and submitted to the instructor, with the course fee, on or before the first class session. The instructor will forward them to UW Extension. Students requesting to register after the first session will need to petition for late registration. Late registrations are subject to a late fee.

**Grading and Student Records** Final quarterly grade reports are not mailed to students. Grades are now accessed online through MyUW at <http://www.myuw.washington.edu>. To access this system you will need your UW Student ID Number and a PAC (Personal Access Code) which you receive with your transaction summary. The grading method for this course is Credit/No Credit only. The standard for granting credit in credit/no credit only courses is the demonstration of competence in the material of the course to the instructor's satisfaction.

The start and end dates of this course may fall within more than one scheduled University of Washington academic quarter. If this is the case, an X will appear on your UW transcript in place of a grade for this course. The X is not a grade, and will be replaced when the course has ended and the instructor submits final grades.

Students requesting to Audit must submit a written statement attached to the registration form. Please note that audited courses do not appear on transcripts. If you have questions regarding grading options, call UW Extension Registration Services, (206) 685 6425.

An instructor can award an incomplete only under special circumstances.

An official UW transcript is established when the first credit course is taken and all future credit course activity is recorded on this permanent record of academic work at the UW. Transcripts for current quarter courses will be available approximately three weeks after the end of the quarter.

**Withdrawal** If you decide not to complete this credit course, you must make an official withdrawal, in writing, to UW Extension Registration Services.

**Refunds** There are no refunds for this course.
