

# Vermont Getaway

**Escape to Vermont and soak up the great outdoors!**

Spend a week in central Vermont. Nestled on the southeast slope of 3000 foot Knox Mountain, our cozy house is at the very end of a well-maintained dead end dirt road. The 5 acre property borders the 26,000 acre Groton State Forest.

- off-the-grid, uses solar power
- extremely private (all-wheel drive highly recommended in winter)
- long range southern views
- 2 bedrooms, plus sleeping space in walkout basement family room
- sleeps 6-10+
- 1 full bath
- open kitchen/dining/living area, lots of natural light
- outdoor gas grill
- spacious porch and deck
- wood-fired hot tub
- miles of trails for hiking, biking, xc skiing, snowshoeing, etc.
- some snowshoes, sleds, and possibly bicycles available
- no telephone—your cell phone will probably work 5 miles west
- satellite TV and Internet, VCR, DVD, board games, and more!
- well-behaved pets are welcomed

Water sports and guided outdoor activities are available at the six state parks located in the State Forest. The Barre/Montpelier area is 30 minutes away, for easy access to stores and civilization, and a country store is 10 minutes away.

The house is currently available any time except November 20-30, December 19 - January 3, September 24–October 16, and Thanksgiving and Christmas 2010.

The house is located about 430 miles from Delaware County, and the drive usually takes us 7-8 hours. It's about 3 hours from Boston, 1.25 hours from the Burlington airport, and 3 hours from Montréal.
